Adult Behavior Guidelines

Due to the growing number of severe incidents of parental violence and misbehavior in youth sports, the Chula Vista Aztecs Youth Football Association has adopted the following:

1) At any youth football/cheerleading event, practice or competition, any adult who: a) verbally abuses; b) attempts to intimidate; c) is flagrantly rude, or, d) cannot control their language or actions with any Participant, Official, Coach, or Youth Volunteer, will be asked to leave the event. He or she will receive a written warning regarding their behavior. His or her child(ren) will be immediately removed from the event.

2) Any adult that commits a second similar offense will be banned from youth football/cheerleading events for the remainder of that season, and their child(ren) will be removed from participation in the youth football/cheerleading program for the remainder of that season.

3) Any adult who physically assaults a Participant, Official, Coach or Youth Volunteer will immediately be banned from youth football/cheerleading and their child(ren) removed from participation in the youth football/cheerleading program for one year from the date of the offense. The child(ren) may not participate in any other youth football/cheerleading Association's Program during the sanction period. After one year, the parent may apply for reinstatement of his or her child(ren). If the adult commits a second offense, he or she will be permanently banned from youth football/cheerleading and the child(ren) permanently removed from participation in youth football/cheerleading.

***The term physical assault includes, but is not limited to: hitting, slapping, pushing, spitting, kicking or striking another person in any way, with any part of the body or any physical implement.**

*** Profanity, obscene gestures, unsportsmanlike behavior, verbal & physical threats and alcohol & tobacco use are prohibited at all times.**
